Dress Rules relating to the Advocates in the Subordinate Courts - Clarification issued by the Bar Council of India, New Delhi - Reg.

The Bar Council of India, New Delhi has issued the following clarification with regard to the Dress Rules to be followed by the Advocates in the Subordinate Courts:

> "In the change brought about in the Dress Rules, there appears to be some confusion in so far as the Sub Courts are concerned. For removal of any doubt it is calrified that so far as the courts other than Supreme Court and High Courts are concerned during summer while wearing black coat is not mandatory, the advocates may appear in white shirt with black or striped or grey pant with black tie or band and collar".

The Bar Council of the State of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad in the reference cited, while forwarding the above decision requested the High Court to issue necessary instructions to the Subordinate Courts for
